
Prayer: giving thanks for the past (interview long standing member of the church about how they have seen God at work over the years? [...?]

St Botolph's. Use us to support, encourage, and serve alongside these our brothers and sisters who minister faithfully in your name. May we be slow to criticise them, and quick to praise them. We ask this so that we may please you, and may grow under Christ our head, to the glory of

your name. Amen.
