General Data Protection Regulations (Update)

G DPR Data Legislation comes into force on May 25th 2018. We have now sent out the first batch of emails and letters seeking your consent (or otherwise) to store your personal data.

We have had a good number of responses but there is still a large number outstanding.

If you don't reply we will be unable to store your data and contact you.

You have the right to say "No" to data being held, either at the time we send the email/letters or in the future. It is important that you reply however, so that we can remove your information from church records, if necessary.
