G DPR Data Legislation comes into force on May 25th 2018. We have now sent out all emails and letters seeking your consent (or otherwise) to store your personal data.

We have had a good number of responses but there is still a large number outstanding.

There have been a number of people who have been unable to use the link from the email. If so, please ask Paul to re-send it, or send a standard email with your consent decision.

If you don't reply we will be unable to store your data and contact you.

You have the right to say "No" to data being held, either at the time we send the email/letters or in the future. It is important that you reply however, so that we can remove your information from church records, if necessary.
