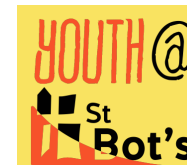

Supplies at the foodbank are low at present, which is often the case at this time of year, but demand remains high.

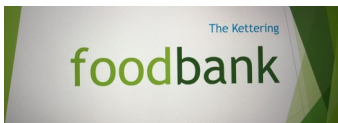
During the school summer holidays, families with children on free school meals need the support the foodbank can give. This tends to increase demand further.

Pray For Leah on 18th July

Leah Sharibu refused to renounce her faith. She paid the price with her freedom. She was one of 110 girls abducted from their school in Dapchi, Nigeria by Boko Haram in February 2018. The next month, following negotiations by the government, the girls were put into trucks to go home. But Leah wasn't among them. She wasn't released because she refused to convert in exchange for her freedom.

Will you pray for Leah's release on 18 July?

Wednesday 18 July marks 150 days since Leah's abduction. Can you gather with your church or small group to pray and take action? Or pray on your own?

The Prayer Room in Church House will be open and available for prayer from 9:30am until 3pm on the 18th July if you wish to come into St Bots to pray for Leah.
