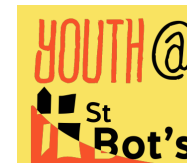


### Request for Qualified 1st Aiders

Supplies at the foodbank are low at present, which is often the case at this time of year, but demand remains high.

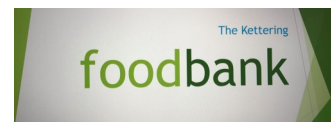
During the school summer holidays, families with children on free school meals need the support the foodbank can give. This tends to increase demand further.

## PCC Summary of Meeting On

25th June 2018

- Mark demonstrated Microsoft Teams which is being used by the PCC to access documents.
- **Finance** - A slight surplus is forecast for the year, which is largely due to a generous gift.
- **Fabric** - Rob Cowan was thanked for the work he has done around Church House. A church cleaning and tidying day is planned for August. 4 new tables have been purchased for Church House.
- **Mission** - There hasn't been a Mission Task Group meeting since the last PCC.
- **Evangelism** - The task group reported on the recent morning at the Frontier Centre where the focus was on getting to grips with personal evangelism. The morning had proved very useful.
