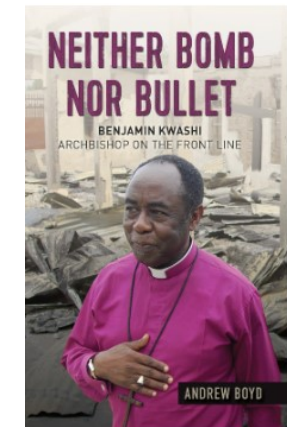

### RELEASE SUPPORTS NEW BOOK ON NIGERIA

Archbishop Ben Kwashi has sent a message of thanks to Release International for backing his new biography, "**Neither Bomb Nor Bullet: Archbishop on the Front Line.**"

The book tells the remarkable story of his three escapes from death in Nigeria, and is infused with his joyful, overcoming faith. 'Three times they've tried to kill me,' he says. 'They've come close. But each time just makes me more determined to live my life to the full for Jesus.'

**Neither Bomb Nor Bullet**, by Andrew Boyd and published by Lion Hudson, is drawn from almost 100 hours of interviews with Release partner Ben Kwashi. It exposes the growing crisis with Islamist militants in Nigeria and is packed with good-humoured stories of faith and courage on the front line.

### Christian Solidarity Worldwide Vietnam

Harassment, intimidation and surveillance are a part of daily life for some of Vietnam's most vulnerable religious and ethnic minorities, including Catholics, Protestants and Hoa Hao Buddhists.

They can also experience arrest, torture and extra-judicial killing.

In April the UN Human Rights Committee urged Vietnam to prevent 'all acts of undue interference' with freedom of religion.

CSW raised similar concerns in a report criticising the use of arbitrary detention and torture against those who defend freedom of religion or belief.

Please pray that the Vietnam government will heed the requests from the UN Human Rights Committee and end the persecution.
