Christian Solidarity Worldwide Egypt

Under President Sisi there have been some advances in freedom of religion or belief, but only for the Christian community. However, while Christians have received greater support from the presidency, discrimination and violence persist at a local level, particularly in Upper Egypt.

In December 2018 the Prime Minister approved the legalisation of 168 churches and buildings belonging to the Coptic Orthodox Church and Evangelical Church. Praise God for this encouraging news, and pray that these churches would be a blessing to their local communities.

Human rights defenders experience official harassment, including travel bans, being summoned for questioning by the authorities, and having their personal, family and organisational assets frozen. Despite this, many persist in their vital work. Give thanks for their courage, and petition God to protect and provide for them

RELEASE SUPPORTS NEW BOOK ON NIGERIA

Archbishop Ben Kwashi has sent a message of thanks to Release International for backing his new biography, "**Neither Bomb Nor Bullet: Archbishop on the Front Line**."

The book tells the remarkable story of his three escapes from death in Nigeria, and is infused with his joyful, overcoming faith. *'Three times they've tried to kill me,' he says. 'They've come close. But each time just makes me more determined to live my life to the full for Jesus.'*

Neither Bomb Nor Bullet, by Andrew Boyd and published by Lion Hudson, is drawn from almost 100 hours of interviews with Release partner Ben Kwashi. It exposes the growing crisis with Islamist militants in Nigeria and is packed with good-humoured stories of faith and courage on the front line.
